

PSCA Hall of Fame Breeder Rules

Any PSCA member will be entered as a PSCA Hall of Fame Breeder who has earned at least 50 points from Pyrenean Shepherds for which they are the breeder of record, based on the following point schedule. (A person will be considered a breeder of record on all dogs for which they are listed on the registration papers as breeder or co-breeder.)

Titles recognized:

- Before Jan. 1, 2005: All titles received in conformation, obedience, agility, herding and tracking will be from PSCA, AKC, CKC, other foreign registries, or other domestic (US) registries or comparable organizations. (Awards will be retroactive to include these titles before Jan. 1, 2005.)
- After Jan. 1, 2005: All titles received in conformation will be from PSCA, CKC, or other foreign registries, until such time when AKC grants CH titles to Pyr Sheps. At that time conformation titles from AKC, CKC, or other foreign registries only will be accepted.
- After Jan. 1, 2005: All titles received in obedience, agility, herding and tracking will be from AKC, CKC, or other foreign registries only.

Other:

- Points are cumulative. (i.e. a dog with a CDX counts its CD as 1 pt. and its CDX as 1 pt. for a total of 2 points.)
- A dog cannot count points from comparable titles from different organizations. (i.e. a dog may not count both a AKC CD and a CKC CD.)
- Proof of titles must be provided for titles from CKC, other foreign registries, or other domestic (US) registries. Titles should be comparable to those in the chart above.

Applications:

- Applications for a Hall of Fame Breeder award must be filled out on the PSCA "Request for Hall of Fame Breeder" form, and accompanied by both proof of titles and breeder of record.
- Any applications submitted that are not legible or submitted as stated above will be returned to sender. All titles must be listed on a separate line. (Forms may be copied.) No fee is necessary.

Eligibility: The PSCA Hall of Fame Breeder Program is for PSCA members only. Certificates will be awarded accordingly.

Recognition: Hall of Fame Breeders will be recognized at the PSCA Annual Meeting each year, and results will also be posted in the next published newsletter. The ROM year will run from Jan 1 to Dec. 31. All submissions must be postmarked by Feb. 1 of the year to be awarded.
